

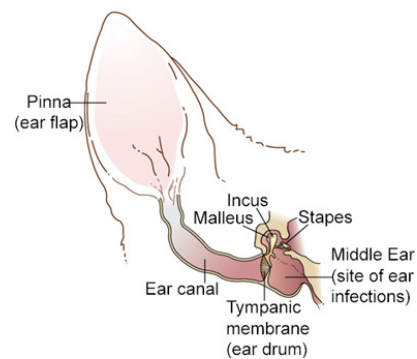


APPLICATION OF EAR DROPS

This ear preparation has been supplied in order to assist in treating your pet's ear complaint. The condition is not uncommon and as mentioned there are a number of possible causes. You have been advised regarding the frequency of application but we thought it would be worthwhile setting out the various steps in actual application of the medication. Please continue with the treatment following the instructions even if an immediate improvement has been seen. This is important.

How do I apply the drops?

It is always easier if you can get someone to assist by holding your dog for you. The head should be gently but firmly held and the ear flap slowly pulled upwards to open the top of the ear canal as much as possible. Squeeze the prescribed number of drops into the upper part of the ear canal then gently massage the ear canal to allow the drops to disperse and to penetrate deep into the ear. With a piece of cotton wool or a piece of tissue on your finger wipe away any excess liquid and debris from around the ear.



DO NOT POKE ANYTHING DOWN THE EAR CANAL SMALLER THAN YOUR FINGER.

In other words, do not use cotton buds. The dog may move and you may as a result cause pain which will make it much more difficult for you to apply the drops next time.

When applying the drops note the colour and consistency of any discharge and if you are at all concerned contact us without delay. If you find it difficult to apply the medication sometimes a simple muzzle will take the dog's mind off what is happening. If you contact us we can supply a suitable muzzle or alternatively one can be improvised from a piece of bandage or an old tie.
